**Parent Consultations** – Thank you all for attending the Parent-Teacher Consultation evenings this week.

**Medicine** – All medicine must be brought to the office and a form must be completed giving us authorisation to administer. Please do not send ANY medicine into school with your child, in their bag. PLEASE make sure that if your child needs an inhaler we have one in school and that they are in date.

**Uniform and P.E Kit** – All uniform and P.E kit must be labelled clearly. P.E kits must also be kept in school every day. A reminder that only shoes should be worn by boys and girls, not trainers or boots. If the weather is poor the children can come to school in boots or wellies and change into their school shoes in the cloakrooms.

## **Vision Screening/Eye Tests – SERVICE WITHDRAWN**

Last year school vision screening in our area detected **296** children with vision problems that would otherwise have gone untreated.

### **THIS SERVICE IS NO LONGER PROVIDED.**

If a child has a vision problem this needs to be treated during the critical period for vision development which ends at around 7/8 years of age.

Children rarely say if they are struggling, and if the problem is in one eye only this will only be detected by an eye test.

## **We strongly recommend that you now book an optician appointment to have your child's eyes tested**

Eye tests for children are **free** on the NHS at any high street optician.

It is recommended that children are tested once a year whether they wear glasses currently or not.

Children's eyes change as they grow, so a need for glasses can occur at any stage even if vision has previously been normal.
