### Emergency Closure Procedure

Now that winter seems to have finally arrived, we would like to remind you of our procedure regarding snowy weather. If, (after severe weather) a decision has to be made to close the school, we will inform you as quickly as possible.

- Closure will be the last resort, but we have to ensure children, parents and staff are safe.
- Parents will be made aware of the closure via a Parent Mail message, on the school website and on the Staff County Council closures list. (Please make sure we have your up to date details).

### Early Close Procedure

If the school has to close during the day, e.g. severe weather, then a decision to close may be made.

We will contact parents as soon as possible by Parent Mail message, asking you to make arrangements to collect your children. If at that time there are any issues, then contact the school as soon as possible. Fingers crossed the weather will be kind this year!

### Winter PE Clothing

A reminder that the children need outdoor PE clothing (tracksuit bottoms, hoody or jumper, trainers) as they will continue to do PE outside this term, including the Mosley Mile. Thank you.



### Young Voices - Tuesday

The children will need to wear **school uniform** as normal and we will give the children their Young Voices **t-shirt** on the day. Children not coming to the concert will stay in school with the remaining teachers. The children have also been asked to bring one **tin** to be collected at the arena. These tins will be used to support the charity Fareshare.

We will have an **early lunch** before we leave school at 12 noon. Children who normally have a school dinner will still be able to do so, in fact it might be a good idea for all the children to have a hot dinner before we leave as they will be having a packed lunch in the evening. Please let the office know if you would like your child to have a school dinner. The children will also need to bring a **packed tea**, which they will have at the arena, and two bottled drinks. No fizzy drinks or glass bottles please.

The concert will start at **7pm**, and it is due to finish at **9.15pm**. All of the schools will be asked to remain in their seats until the audience has dispersed at the end of the concert. For safety reasons we will then bring the children **back to school** on the coach, so all of the children can be collected from school. We will also send a message to let you know the approximate time we will be arriving back at school so please check for messages. Please collect your child from the classroom doors.
