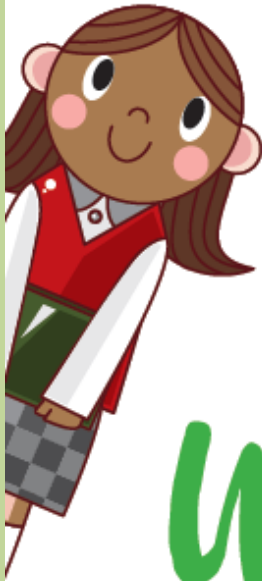
IMPORTANT – Staff Car Park
