Word / letter sounds:	Examples:
'dge' ("j")	badge, bridge, edge, fudge
c ("s")	city, race, cell, ice
kn ("nn")	knock, know, knee
wr ("rr")	write, wrong, wrap, written
le	table, apple, bottle, little
el	camel, tunnel, squirrel, towel
al	metal, medal, capital, hospital
il	pencil, fossil, nostril
y ("I")	cry, fly, reply, July
Adding 'es' to words	flies, tries, implies, babies
Adding 'ed' / 'ing' / 'est' to words ending in 'y'	copied, copier, happier, happiest, cried, replied - copying, crying, replying
Adding 'ed' / 'ing' / 'est' to words ending in 'e'	hiked, hiking, nicer, nicest, shined, shining
Adding 'ing', 'est', 'er', 'y' to words ending in single consonant letter after single vowel	patting, humming, dropping, sadder, saddest, fatter
al ("or")	walk, talk, all, call, always
o ("u")	other, mother, nothing, Monday
ey	donkey, monkey, chimney, valley
a ("o")	watch, wander, quantity, squash
or ("er")	work, worm, world, worth

Suffix - ness	sadness, happiness, loneliness
Suffix - ment	merriment, enjoyment, disappointment
Suffix - ful	hopeful, careful, playful
Suffix - ly	badly, happily, lonely
Contractions	can't, don't, won't, couldn't, it's
Possessive apostrophe	Megan's, the girl's, the man's
tion	station, fiction, motion, action
homophones - (same sound/different spelling)	there / their / they're, here/hear, see/sea, bare/bear, blue/blew
