Sticks for Forest School – do you have any sticks that you could give us for Forest School? We need some sticks measuring between 2m and 3m if you have access to any.

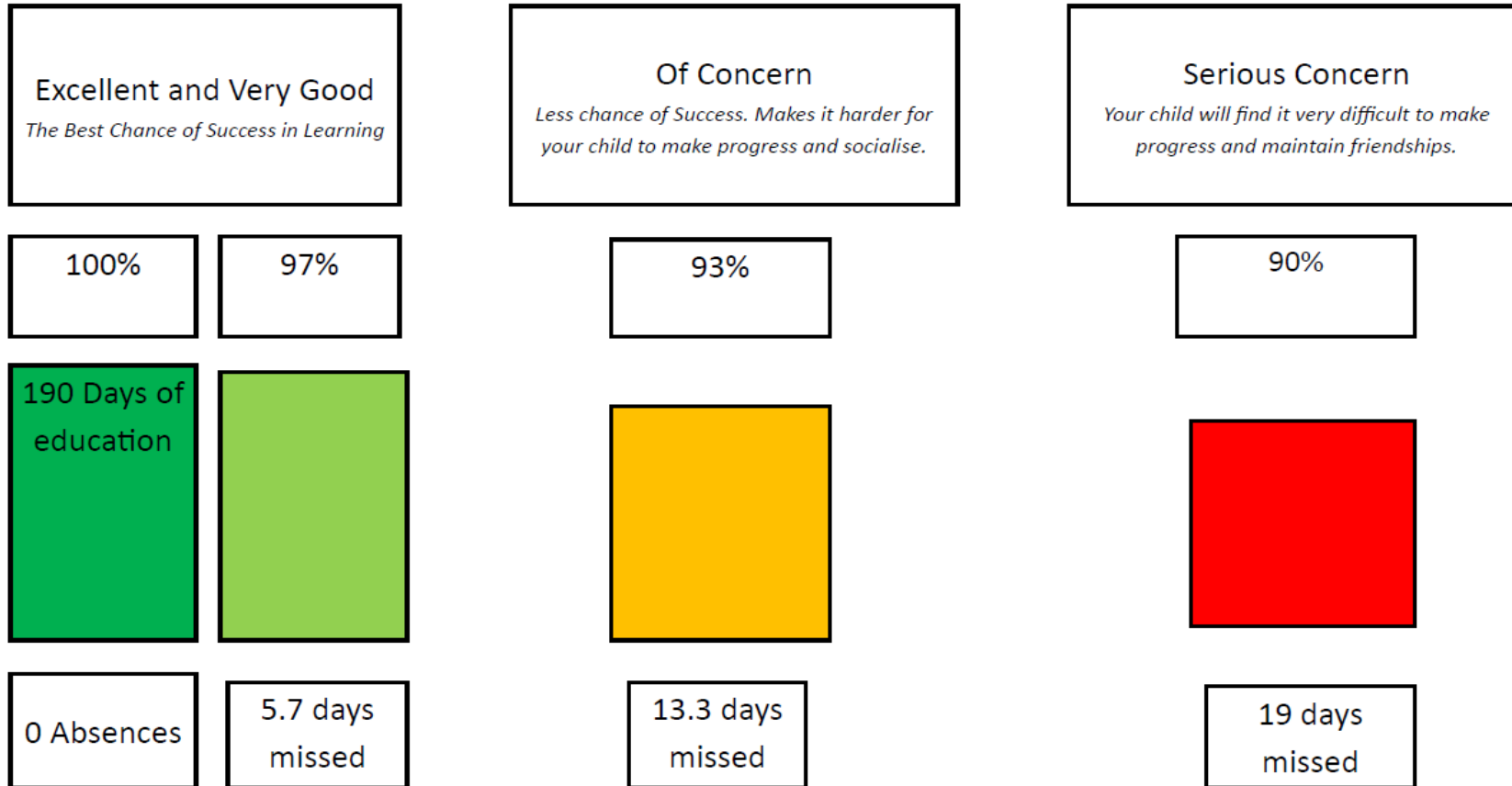
