New Term Information - September 2020

It has been fantastic seeing everyone back at school. Here are some reminders:

Medicine – All medicine must be brought to the office and a form must be completed giving us authorisation to administer. Please do not send ANY medicine into school with your child, in their bag. PLEASE make sure that if your child needs an inhaler we have one in school.

Uniform and P.E Kit – All uniform and P.E kit **must** be labelled clearly please. P.E kits must also be kept in school every day.

Snacks – please send your child with a healthy snack if they would like one at break time, e.g. a piece of fruit or cereal bar. No crisps, chocolate or sweets. Please remember we are a PEANUT FREE school. The children in R/1/2 will have access to the free fruit scheme. Snacks will be available at break time to all pupils at a cost of 30p for toast and 40p for hot chocolate. Please send the children with exact change due to reduce the need to handle change. Thank you.

Bags – A health and safety reminder that children should not be bringing large rucksacks into school. They take up too much space in the cloakrooms and, consequently, end up on the floor causing trip hazards.

Appointments – Please make appointments for your child out of school hours wherever you can, either after school or during holidays.

Thank you to everyone for following the new routines and procedures that are now in place. The children have coped brilliantly and it has been wonderful to have them back in school this week. Please remember that we are doing our best to make school as safe as possible and we are following Government guidelines. Please continue to support us. Thank you.

AMPS Fundraising at home Challenge

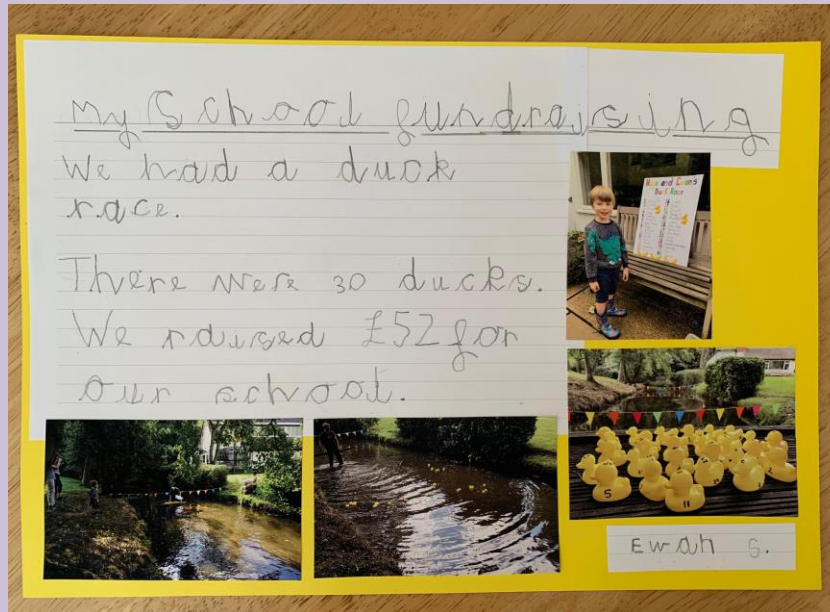
Thank you so much to the children and families who have taken part in fundraising this summer to raise money for the AMPS (PTA).
